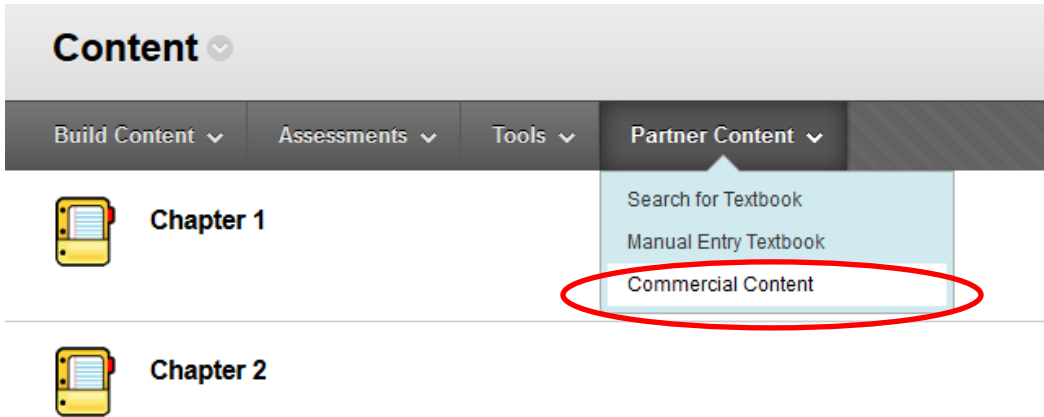


Quick Steps to Pair Your Connect Course

1. From within your Blackboard Learn course, go to any course content area, locate the Partner Content tab and select Commercial Content.



2. Select the McGraw-Hill icon from the Available Partners carousel and click anywhere on the banner to get started.

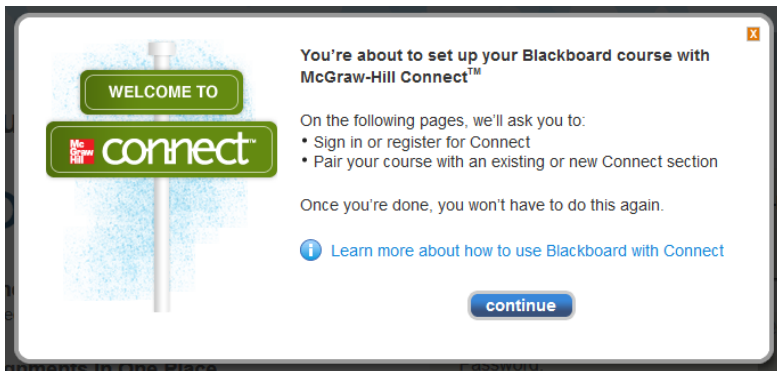



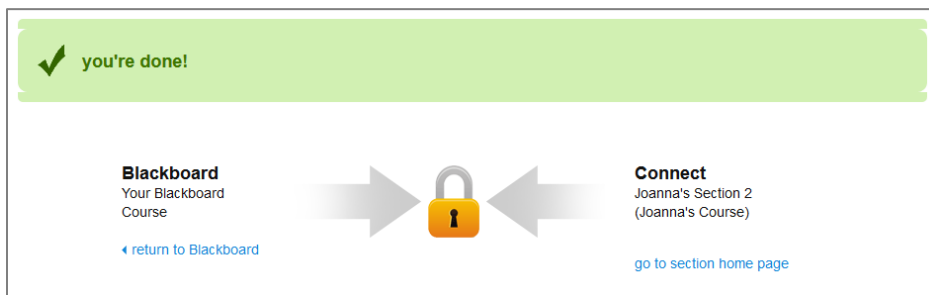
